## Litter Registration Policy

---

1. The ABS Inc will not register litters where the sire/dam have the following relationships:
  - (a) father/daughter
  - (b) mother/son
  - (c) brother/sister
  - (d) half brother/half sister
  - (e) grandparent/grandpup
2. The ABS completed foundation breeding a long time ago. The ABS will not register a litter where mother/father is another breed, or mother/father is a straight cross of two other breeds (e.g. British Bulldog x Bullmastiff).

A first generation dog cannot be transferred/registered with ABS Inc.

A first generation dog cannot be mated to another first generation dog

A first generation dog born prior to 31/10/09 can be sire/dam to an ABS registered litter if such dog meets all other ABS requirements

3. 2nd Generation dogs will be cut out of the breeding program for DOGS BORN AFTER 31/10/2018, as Minuted & agreed at the ABS General Meeting March 2018.
4. All other dogs registered with another body can apply for ABS Inc registration (given they fulfil all ABS health/colour policy criteria) and will be considered by ABS Management Committee on a case by case basis. Management Committee decision is final.
5. A dog of solid colour with black or liver mask is perfectly acceptable within the ABS Inc. for breeding. However a dog that is solid fawn with a black or liver mask or solid red with a black or liver mask is not to be mated to another solid fawn with a black or liver mask or solid red with a black or liver mask dog within the ABS Inc. (i.e. dogs with no white or only a tiny thin streak of white down face - if in doubt, ask ABS Registrar for clarification before any mating takes place).
6. No white dog is to be mated to another white dog within the ABS Inc.
7. Breaches of the ABS Inc Code of Ethics can result in Official Warnings with you having to supply 'just cause' on why your Membership is not terminated (depending on severity) OR automatic termination of Membership after three official warnings as Minuted in 2011.
